2019 NWT Community Survey

- This survey has been conducted every 5 years since 1984
- Designed to provide community level information in between Census years
- This year, heavy emphasis on housing to coordinate content with the Canadian Housing Survey



General Content

- Housing Conditions
- Labour Force Statistics
- Education Levels
- Traditional Activities
- Ability to speak Indigenous Language



General Content

- Data is often available by:
 - NWT community or region
 - Sex and age
 - Indigenous/Non-Indigenous



New Content

- Housing Satisfaction
- Outstanding Mortgage Owed
- Ability to Make Ends Meet
- Indigenous Languages



Current Operations

- Also conducting a full price survey which will be available by end of the summer
- Hoping to complete operations of the community survey by the end of March or early April at the latest
 - Travel completed in 10 communities, may follow up by phone
 - Ongoing in 13 communities
 - Still need to visit 11 communities

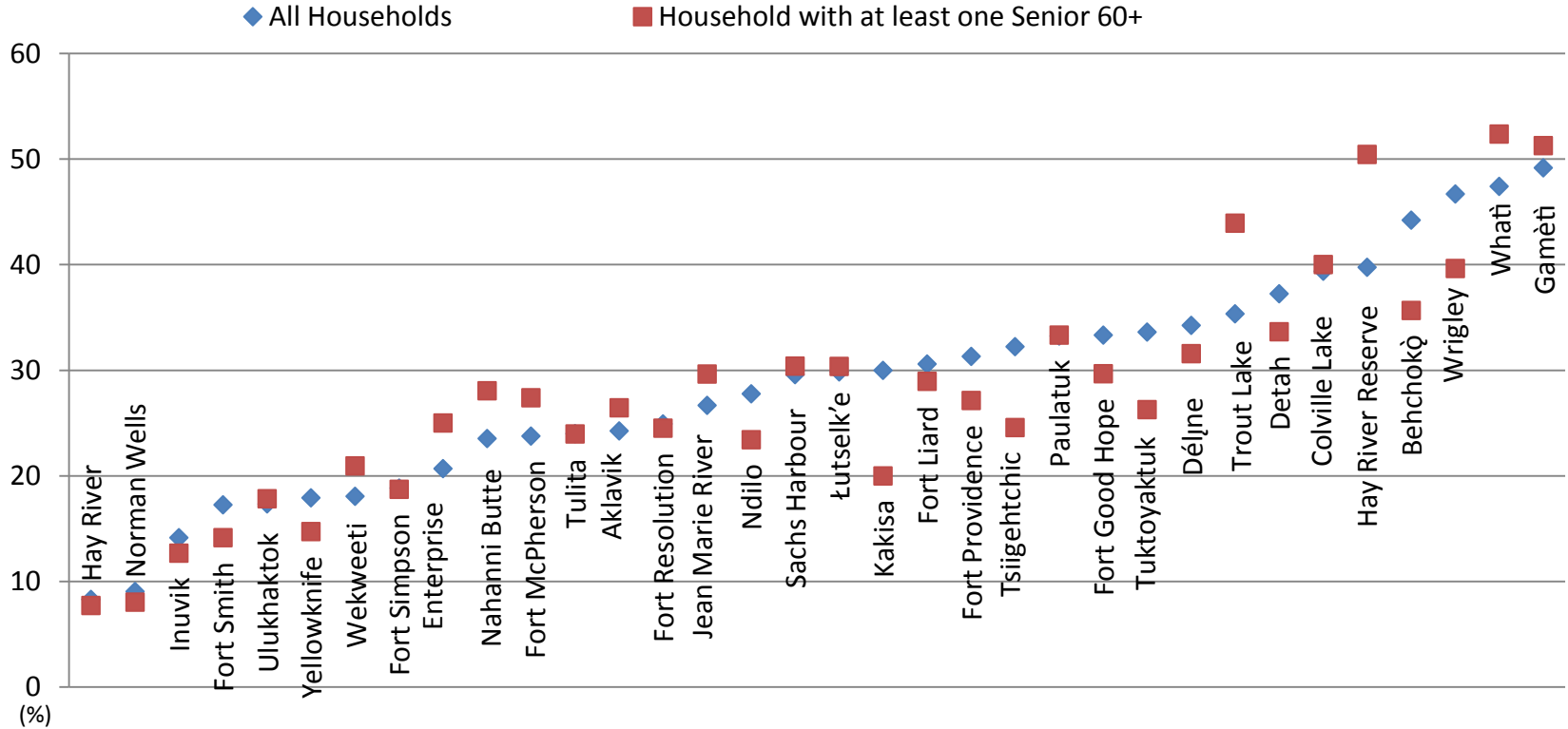


Dissemination

- Don't hesitate to ask for any additional data that is of interest to you

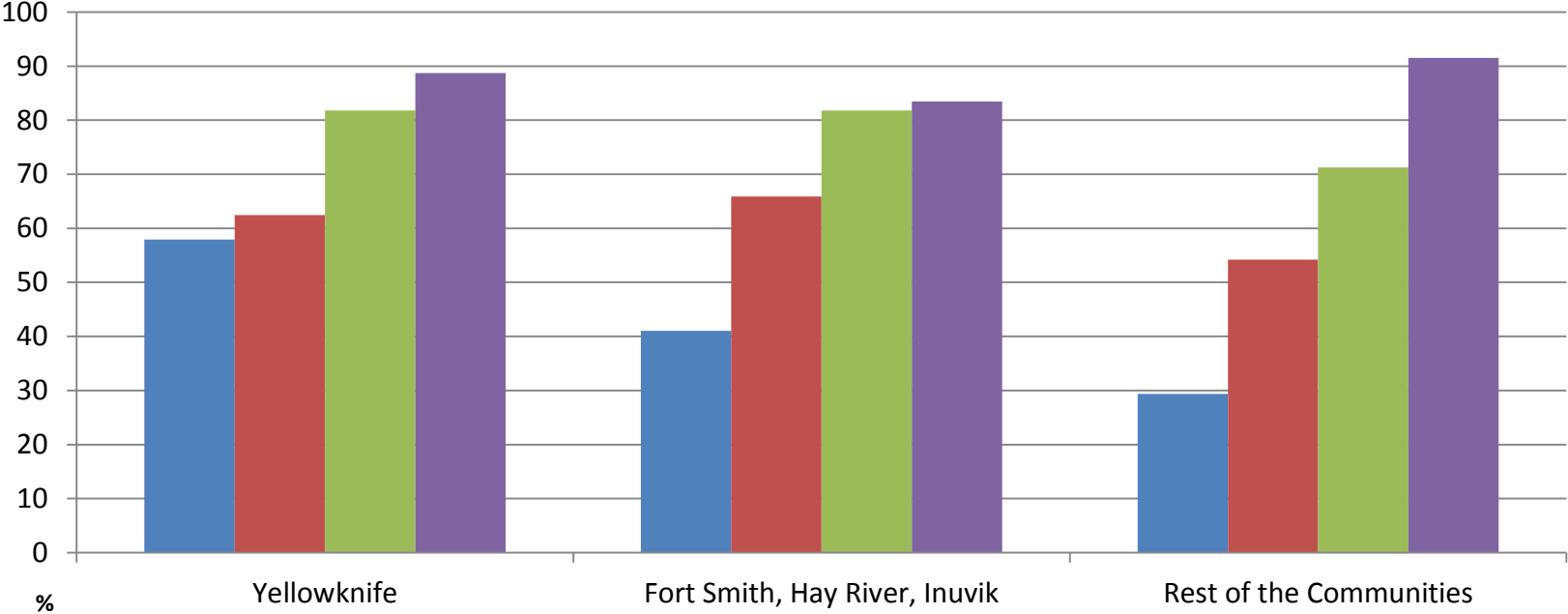


% of Households in Core Need, 2014
