The Anti-Poverty Fund



The Anti-Poverty Fund is \$1 million distributed every year to community governments and organizations. It is for projects intended to reduce and end poverty. The Anti-Poverty Fund (APF) has a mandate to support and fund Anti-Poverty initiatives in the Northwest Territories (NWT) that demonstrate tangible action towards the reduction of poverty in the NWT. This fund is one of the Government of the Northwest Territories (GNWT) commitments under the Territorial Anti-Poverty Action Plan (TAPAP). It is intended to support the efforts of TAPAP partners.

GHG Grant Program for Buildings and Industry

The Government of the Northwest Territories' (GNWT) GHG Grant Program for Buildings and Industry is an application based non-repayable grant program designed to support greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions reduction projects and initiatives for NWT businesses, industry and non-profit organizations.

Funding and resources for this program have been provided jointly by the GNWT in support of the GNWT's 2030 Energy Strategy, and by Environment and Climate Change Canada (ECCC) under the Low Carbon Economy Leadership Fund (LCELFF) in support of the Pan-Canadian Framework on Clean Growth and Climate Change.

The program is accepting applications on an annual basis over the next three years.

The program ends March 31, 2022.
