There are currently 170 confirmed cases of COVID-19 in the NWT.

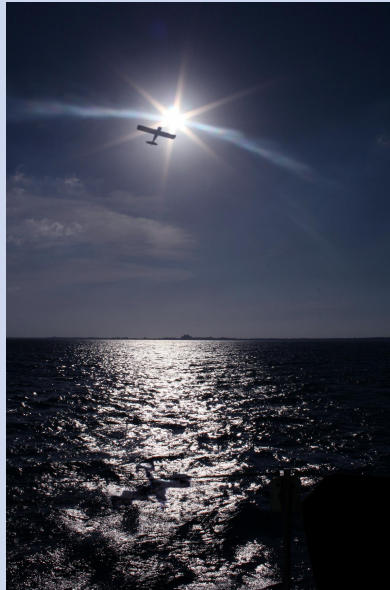

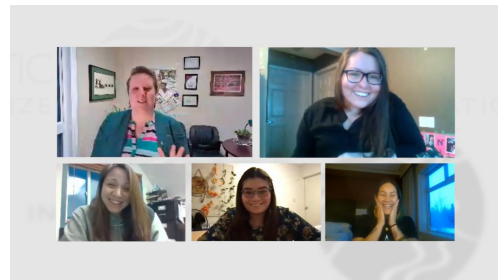

RURAL TRANSIT SOLUTIONS FUND

The Rural Transit Solutions Fund seeks to help Canadians living in rural and remote areas get around their communities more easily and connect with nearby communities.

It is the first federal fund to target the development of transit solutions in rural communities. \$250 million in federal funding will be available over 5 years, beginning in 2021, to support the development of locally-driven and transit solutions that will help people living in rural communities get to work, school, appointments, and visit loved ones.
