

"Drive to 75 %" Vaccine Initiative

Residents in the Northwest Territories (NWT) are being encouraged to make the push to reach 75 percent uptake for full vaccination (2 doses) in the territory.


Higher vaccination rates will help to ensure protection for individuals, families, and communities as fall approaches and the Delta variant of COVID-19 becomes more prevalent across the country.

VOLUNTEER RECOGNITION FUNDING

Community governments can apply for contributions up to one thousand dollars (\$1000) per year for eligible costs related to hosting community recognition events.

The NWT Association of Communities in collaboration with the Government of the Northwest Territories is issuing a second call for applications for funds available to

NWT communities and Indigenous Governments for local-level promotion of the COVID-19 vaccine.
