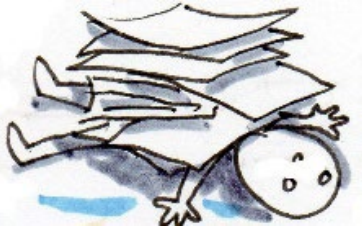

Examples of current partnership projects

Community building foundation reviews

The foundations of community-owned buildings were reviewed in 10 communities with the highest risk of damage due to permafrost thaw. Community governments now have more information to plan for the maintenance and operation of their buildings and identify where additional funding is needed to respond to permafrost thaw.



Wildfire preparedness

NWTAC and the GNWT secured \$20M through DMAF, Infrastructure Canada's Disaster Mitigation and Adaptation Fund. This funding enables all 29 communities facing wildfire risk to complete their firebreaks.
