### **Award Description**

#### Goal

 Celebrate an NWT community that demonstrates leadership in improving energy efficiency and reducing greenhouse gas emissions.

#### Eligibility

All 33 community governments in the NWT

#### Criteria

Communities are invited to demonstrate how they are actively improving energy efficiency and reducing greenhouse gas emissions. Examples of eligible actions include:

- Integrating energy efficiency and emissions reduction into community budgets, policies, bylaws, operations, and planning frameworks.
- Enhancing infrastructure and operations through energy audits, implementation of recommendations, and other initiatives that improve overall energy performance.
- Conducting planning and assessment projects, such as updating a community energy plan, evaluating the community's energy footprint, or identifying opportunities to transition to renewable energy sources.
- Engaging residents by offering programs, workshops, and initiatives that empower individuals to learn about and take action to reduce their carbon footprint.
- Collaborating with partners including other communities, organizations, and levels of government to advance energy efficiency and emission reduction goals.
- Participating in capacity-building initiatives, such as training sessions, pilot studies, or workshops that strengthen local expertise in energy management and sustainability.

#### **Award Details**

A grant of **\$5,000** will be awarded to one community to support a new or existing initiative focused on improving energy efficiency or reducing emissions.
